Fairbanks/3 Nights, Denali/2 Nights, Anchorage/1 Night, Alyeska/2 Nights, Homer/2 Nights

July 16 - DAY 1 Transfer between the Fairbanks airport and the hotel is included. Overnight Fairbanks.

July 17 - DAY 2 This morning travel by deluxe motorcoach to the nearby community of North Pole, Alaska for a visit to the Santa Claus House giftshop. Have a chance to meet some of Santa's Reindeer! This afternoon enjoy a brief Fairbanks city tour and a ride in the *Riverboat Discovery* on the Chena and Nenana Rivers. The riverboat stops at a recreated Athabascan Indian Village where you will learn about the Native people's way of life. This evening a dinner is included at a local musher's house. Meet the current and future athletes that participate in Alaska's official state sport. Overnight Fairbanks. Meals: Dinner

July 18 - DAY 3 Enjoy a brief a visit to the 800-mile Trans-Alaska Oil Pipeline. Next you will learn more about the area's rich, gold-rush history as you visit Gold Dredge #8. Spend this afternoon at the resort at Chena Hot Springs where you will have a chance to soak in the naturally heated pools. Upon your return to Fairbanks you will have an included, all-you-can-eat dinner at the Alaska Salmon Bake. Overnight Fairbanks. Meals: Dinner

July 19 - DAY 4 This morning travel by deluxe motorcoach from Fairbanks to Denali. If the weather cooperates the best views of Mt. Denali are near Nenana. This afternoon is open for optional activities such as whitewater rafting, flightseeing, hiking or one of the Park Service programs. This evening enjoy an included dinner at a local restaurant (request 49th State). Overnight Denali. Meals: Dinner

July 20 - DAY 5 Today is open for optional activities such as whitewater rafting, flightseeing, hiking, or one of the Park Service programs. Overnight Denali.

July 21 - DAY 6 This morning travel by deluxe motorcoach to the quaint and historic community of Talkeetna. Enjoy some time to explore this town before boarding the Deluxe Dome Railcars for a scenic train ride to Alaska's largest city, Anchorage. Overnight Anchorage.

July 22 - DAY 7 This morning enjoy a brief Anchorage city tour. Later, travel by deluxe motorcoach to the quaint community of Girdwood. This afternoon visit the *Alaska Wildlife Conservation Center* to learn about the iconic wildlife that lives throughout the Last Frontier. A ride on the Alyeska Tram is included today. Overnight Girdwood.

July 23 - DAY 8 Today is open for optional activities such as helicopter flightseeing, hiking, a scenic float, or time on own in the local community. Overnight Girdwood.

July 24 - DAY 9 From Alyeska this morning travel by deluxe motorcoach along the Turnagain Arm, where the mountains rise out of the sea. Continue through the mountains of the Kenai Peninsula down the coast of Cook Inlet with views of volcanoes on the other side of the Inlet to Homer. Included this afternoon is a city orientation tour of Homer including the famous, Homer Spit. Overnight Homer.

July 25 - DAY 10 Open day in Homer to explore this community. Book a day out on the water for Halibut or Salmon fishing, ride one of the ferries to the remote communities of Halibut Cove or Seldovia, or simply stay in town to enjoy the many local galleries and restaurants. A visit to the *Alaska Islands & Ocean Visitor Center* is included today. Overnight Homer.

July 26 - DAY 11 Today travel by deluxe motorcoach from Homer to Seward for ship embarkation.

July 27th - Day 12 Cruising Hubbard Glacier

July 28th - Day 13 Icy Strait Point, Alaska

July 29th - Day 14 Juneau, Alaska / Cruising Endicott Arm & Dawes Glacier

July 30th - Day 15 Skagway, Alaska

July 31st - Day 16 Ketchikan, Alaska

August 1st - Day 17 Cruise Inside Passage

August 2nd - Day 18 Vancouver, BC
